Problem Statement: In a similar fashion to the marble race, we had to use teamwork to toss tubes around a circle. We can use only our right hand and toss to the left. Everyone has a tube that they pass. There are three rounds: 1. sitting, 2. standing, 3. standing, alternating passes. Team must continue in a stage until everyone could catch the tube. A mistake in the 2nd or 3rd stage results in a total start over from the 1st stage.

Approach:
